

SWIMMING POOL – INGROUND PERMIT APPLICATION

The following is a guideline of requirements that need to be met along with the completed application.

APPLICATION:

- Submit a completed application.
- ❖ If you have a <u>Septic tank</u> in your yard, you must <u>first</u> contact the Will County Health Department, Northern Branch at (630) 679-7030. You must get an approval from the Health Department and submit a copy of the approval with your application.
- ❖ Submit two (2) copies of the plat of survey indicating the <u>location</u>, <u>size</u> and <u>distance</u> of the pool from the <u>house</u> as well as the distance from the <u>side</u> and <u>rear</u> lot lines. Also, indicate location of all equipment (filters, pumps etc.) related to the pool.
- Submit 2 copies of the specifications of the pool and pool equipment.
- ❖ Check with your Homeowners Association regarding covenant restrictions. (**must comply**)
- ❖ Contact JULIE, INC. at 811 Two (2) working days prior to digging to locate utilities.
- ❖ Check with water billing at (815) 439-2923 for a one time sewer reduction on your first fill.

CODE REQUIREMENTS:

- See Municipal Code, Article VII, Swimming Pool Regulations or at www.plainfield-il.org.
- The pool <u>cannot</u> be located within any easement and must be a minimum of 10' FEET from all property lines and the house.
- ❖ The walkway or patio around the pool cannot be located in any easement. As well as the pool equipment.
- ❖ In-ground pools shall not change or alter the existing grading or overland flood routes as indicated on the final plat of survey.
- All pool equipment must be on a GFCI (ground fault circuit interrupter) protected circuit.
- No current carrying electrical conductors shall cross the pool, either overhead or underground. All underground current shall be a minimum of 5' FEET from the pool. All overhead shall be a minimum of 18' FEET from the pool.
- **Extension cords are not allowed for the pool pumps.**

- ❖ The gas line pipe for the pool heater must be an approved material (Black pipe is <u>NOT</u> allowed). See attached.
- ❖ Yards with In-ground pools must have a minimum in height of a 5' foot fence either surrounding the pool or a fence surrounding the perimeter of the yard no less than 5' FEET from grade with locking gates. The fence <u>must</u> be installed prior to filling the pool. *See Municipal Code, Article VII, Swimming pool regulations, Construction requirements, Sec.2.5-137, (d) Fences, (e) Steps or ladders.
- ❖ A temporary construction fence must be in place <u>immediately</u> for (sunken) above ground pools and all Inground pools.

INSPECTIONS:

- Pre-pour Concrete Inspection
- Electrical (Bonding) Inspection
- Plumbing (gas line) Inspection
- Final Electric Inspection
- Final Building Inspection.
- ❖ The "Temporary" construction fence must be removed and a permanent fence in place for Final Inspection.

PERMIT FEES:

❖ In Ground Pool permit fee is \$150.00 and is due at time of issuance.

NOTE: If the permit is not picked up within 30 days of approval it will be VOIDED and you will need to reapply.
